Archery Ontario and Archery Canada Covid-19 Range Protective Measures

Archery Range Field Operations: All activity on the range must comply with the physical distancing measures, recommendations and requirements issued by federal, provincial/territorial and municipal authorities. Range access is for pre-registered members only that are deemed low risk by not outwardly showing any signs or symptoms of Covid-19 and have not been out of the province or country in the last 14 days. There should be no congregating in parking lot before and after range access.

Gathering area: All benches and picnic table must be inaccessible and removed to avoid gatherings.

Cleaning/Hygiene: Members are responsible for providing their own cleaning and disinfecting cleansers to clean surfaces that are frequently touched by members such as bow racks and targets etc.

Range Shooting Procedures (3D and Field Target): Members will be responsible for sanitizing each target after use. Limit no more than one archer per target that are not from the same household unit and up to four archers who are within the same household unit to accommodate rules of social distancing. Groups shall not proceed to the next target until the previous group has cleared the target area. Any child under the age of 18 will need to be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times on 3D course and field targets. This guardian will be counted as a member of the shooting group even though they are not participating. All garbage such as paper towels, hand wipes or cleaning clothes shall be put in garbage can.

Classes/Lessons: All lessons have been cancelled for this 2020 season.

Archer Etiquette and Best Practices Respect and Physical distancing

As much as possible, maintain a 2m distance from other archers, unless they are from your household. Archers are to recognize that others on the range may have different levels of comfort and therefore should be treated with respect, given appropriate physical distance and should exercise patience at all times.

Hygiene: Bring your own hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes with you to the range. Avoid touching common surfaces as best as possible, and if you do touch something, make sure to wash your hands and disinfect the surface you have touched including when using the washroom (outhouse). Hand sanitizer will be available in the washroom.

Archery Equipment: Use only your own personal equipment. Do not touch or borrow other people's equipment.

Stay home and let others play safely: Archers who are not feeling well, exhibit flu-like symptoms or know they have been in contact with someone who has been sick should exercise appropriate isolation and contact Mike leeder if you have been out to the range.

After shooting: Wipe down any surface you have touched or placed your equipment on. Leave immediately so that others can come onto the range.

Communications: Emails will sent out to update members of any further changes to Archery Ontario guidelines.
